Initiated and developed by Ewha Institute for Leadership Development, Scranton Women's Leadership Center, the United Board for Christian Higher Education in Asia, this course is designed to develop leadership potentials for women leaders in Asia, advance their academic careers, and empower them to flourish in the post-pandemic era by upholding adaptability and expanding global vision. WoLA aims to provide an invaluable opportunity for women leaders to harness their leadership skills and forge a strong network with ambitious peers from various cultural backgrounds. WoLA graduates will be able to show their leadership and make a positive impact in their communities with confidence, visionary leadership, and mutual support.

A. WoLA Application with Full Scholarship

Application Period: Aug 30 - Sep 15, 2021

Eligibility

- 1. Emerging **women leaders** from **higher education institutions in Asia**, who commit to attend and fulfill the entirety of the course, including 2 synchronous sessions
 - a. Synchronous session 1:Monday, Oct 25, 2021, 3 PM or Tuesday, Oct 26, 2021, 11 AM
 - b. Synchronous session 2: Monday, Nov 8, 2021, 3 PM or Tuesday, Nov 9, 2021, 11AM
 - * Above times are written in Korea Standard Time.
 - * Participants must choose and attend one of the two timeslots provided for each synchronous session.
 - * Each session will last for about two hours.
- 2. A full-time faculty or staff at a college or university in Asia with at least 10 or more years of service **left** before retirement at the home institution
- 3. Demonstrated leadership within their home institutions and willingness to advance women's leadership
- 4. Fluent in written and spoken English

Priority will be given to applicants with the following criteria:

- Applicants from institutions in the *United Board for Christian Higher Education in Asia's* network: https://unitedboard.org/about-us/our-network/
- Applicants who demonstrate strong dedication and commitment to bring positive impact to their home institutions upon completion of WoLA.
 - * Diversity of institutions will be considered during the screening process.

Application Process

- 1. Fill in and submit WoLA Application with Full Scholarship: https://bit.lv/applvWOLAscholarship
- 2. The scholarship application includes two essay prompts to be answered together in 300 to 500 words total.
 - (1) Why do you want to take this course?
 - (2) How would you advance women's leadership within your home institution upon completion of the course?
- 3. Endorsement form to be filled out by the head of your institution or senior leadership: https://bit.ly/wola-endorsement
- 4. Application and endorsement form due by Wednesday, September 15, 2021
- 5. Final announcement of scholarship results via email on Tuesday, September 28, 2021

B. WoLA General Application

Application Period: Aug 30 - Sep 24, 2021

Eligibility

- 1. Emerging **women leaders** from **higher education institutions in Asia**, who commit to attend and fulfill the entirety of the course, including 2 synchronous sessions
 - a. Synchronous session 1: Monday, Oct 25, 2021, 3 PM or Tuesday, Oct 26, 2021, 11 AM
 - b. Synchronous session 2: Monday, Nov 8, 2021, 3 PM or Tuesday, Nov 9, 2021, 11AM
 - * Above times are written in Korea Standard Time.
 - * Participants must choose and attend one of the two timeslots provided for each synchronous session.
 - * Each session will last for about two hours.
- 2. Fluent in written and spoken English

- 2. Wire transfer WoLA program fee and attach a copy of the receipt in the application form. Your application will not be considered complete without the receipt of the program fee.
- 3. Application and WoLA course fees are due by Friday, September 24, 2021
- 4. Acknowledgment of receipt of your application and the course fee will be sent out on Thursday, September 30, 2021.
